



LADIES LEAGUE FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What is the cost for Ladies League? When does it start and end?

A: The league fee is \$40; the weekly substitute fee is \$7. Green fees are included for King's Walk members. Non-members need to pay a weekly green fee or purchase punch cards. League play starts on May 23rd and ends on August 22nd. The banquet and awards will be on August 29th.

Q: Do I have to be a member to play in league?

A: No. Non-members would need to pay a weekly green fee or purchase punch cards. The weekly green fee is \$23, a cart seat is \$12. A 10-round, 9-hole punch card for golf is \$210 and a 10-round, 9-hole punch card for the cart is \$110.

Q: How does Ladies League work?

A: Each week will have a different game along with on-course pin games. Players can make their own group, or the golf shop will find a group for you to play with. Players can stop by or call the golf shop to book a tee time for Ladies League. Tee times are reserved from 4:15-6:15pm every Tuesday evening from late May to late August.

Q: Do I have to show up every week?

A: No. You can show up as you're able too.

Q: Do I need to be good to play in the league?

A: No. Players of all abilities are welcome to join for "friendly" competition and socializing.
