



MONDAY MEN'S CLUB FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: How do I sign up with a group?

A: New and past players can sign up individually, with a friend, or with a group. A friend group is called a "POD". Players can register and pay at the King's Walk Golf Shop or on-line at kingswalk.org.

Q: What are the costs?

A: \$80 league fee covers the prizes and all players must have a USGA handicap. Non-members pay the 9-hole green fee. Punch cards are available to lower the costs further.

Q: Can I add more people to our "POD" after league play starts?

A: Absolutely! We are always looking to add more players.

Q: Will I play with the same person every week if I sign up with a group?

A: If you are in a pod with friends, typically one person from your pod and two players from another pod. Monday Men's Club is designed to play with friends, network, and meet new people.

Q: Does Monday Men's Club allow substitutes?

A: Yes. The sub pays \$7 for a weekly fee and a weekly green fee if they are not a member.

Q: When does the league start and end?

A: Regular season play begins on May 13th and ends on August 26th. Postseason play on September 9th, 16th. Fun night and our awards banquet, September 23rd.

Q: Do I need to show up every week?

A: No. If you can't make it, notify the golf shop by Monday morning of the week you will miss.

Q: What types of formats are played weekly?

A: A variety of team and individual formats. See weekly schedule.

Q: What type of players usually play in the league?

A: Open to players of all abilities for "friendly competition". Net scoring helps level the field, so everyone has a chance to win. Golfers of all ages 18+ and abilities are welcome.

Q: How do the prize payouts work?

A: Typically, the top 3 teams (groups that play together) played on the front and back nine. There are also course games such as closest to the pin.

Q: What time does the league start each week?

A: 6:00pm shotgun start for most. You can also book any available tee time on Monday if you prefer to play earlier.

Q: What tee do I play?

A: The handicap formula makes competition fair no matter which tees you play. Our recommendation plus age and ability will help us choose the correct tee for your game.
