



MEN'S MATCH PLAY FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What is the Thursday Match Play League?

A: It is a weekly 9-hole league with 14 teams consisting of 4 players (ABCD). Each team will play the other 13 league teams in match play format. Players collect points for their teams during matches. (2 points for each hole won, 1 point for each hole tied, 2 points for winning a match, and 1 point for tying a match.) 3 of the top 4 scores from each week will be counted toward the team total.

Q: When does the league start?

A: The meet your team scramble and regular season play begins early May. Regular season matches are played until mid-August. Playoffs go from end of August to early September. Lastly, the fun night and banquet is mid-September. It starts at 6:00pm every Thursday as a shotgun start.

Q: What is the cost of the league?

A: The league fee is \$100. Substitutes would pay a weekly fee of \$10. Green fees are included for members. Substitutes would pay the weekly fee and a green fee or can use a punch card. All players are required to have a GHIN handicap.

Q: When is the deadline to sign up?

A: May 1st is the deadline to sign up, however it is open to the first 56 players who sign up.

Q: How are the teams decided?

A: Teams are decided based on the handicap of a player in a rotating fashion. The lowest handicapped "A" player would be paired with the highest handicapped "B" player. This same process would be continued with the C & D players.

Q: Do I need a handicap to play?

A: Yes, we require all players to have a GHIN handicap.

Q: Do I need to show up every week?

A: Yes. All 13 regular season matches need to be played, however matches can be made up within the regular season if needed. Missing a match could affect your team's point total and playoff positioning. Make-up matches can be scheduled.

Q: Are there weekly prizes?

A: Yes. Each week there is a skins game for \$5 (lowest score on a hole against those who sign up in your division) and on-course pin games. At the fun night banquet, individual and team awards/payouts will be presented.

Q: If I can't make it for a match, how do I find a substitute?

A: At the beginning of the season a league booklet will be provided to all the players with contact information for each player and those on the sub list. If you are not able to make it for a match, it is your responsibility to find a sub for that night or to schedule a makeup match. On the sub list, a player of equal skill would need to make up your match. For example, a player listed as an "A" on the sub list cannot sub to play a match against a "D" player.
